Camperships are given to offset the difference that a Scout, their family, a volunteer (supplemental training), and the unit cannot cover towards the youths' camp fee or training. *With rare exceptions, a granted Campership does not exceed 50% of the given fee.* The campership committee feels that it is important for a Scout or Scouter to contribute some portion of his fees through personal resources or unit fundraising projects, thus meeting the spirit of the 9th point of the Scout Law - A Scout is "Thrifty" - a Scout pays their own way. Donor restrictions maintain that all available campership funds are to be used for attendance at the prescribed Orange County Council camps or specified training.
